## INTROIT

*Ego autem in Domino sperabo* — Psalm 31

*But I will hope in the Lord: I will be glad, and rejoice in thy mercy; for thou hast regarded my humility. Psalm. In thee, O Lord, have I hoped, let me never be confounded: deliver me in thy justice, and rescue me.*

## COLLECT OF THE DAY
