## INTROIT

*Deus in adjutorium* — Psalm 70

*O God, come to my assistance, O Lord, make haste to help me: let my enemies be confounded and ashamed that seek my soul. Psalm. Let them be turned backward and blush for shame, that desire evils to me.*

## COLLECT OF THE DAY

*Grant us, we beseech thee, O Lord, the help of thy grace: that being duly intent on fasts and prayers, we may be delivered from enemies of mind and body. Through our Lord, &c.;*
